Background Check / Coach Training Policy

2010

Definition [Manager/Coach]: Any person providing strategy or instruction to a player from the dugout or the field.

Background Checks

Leagues must submit an Excel spreadsheet supplied from their respective JOA back to their JOA with a league check for \$9 per background check. Leagues must include all Managers/Coaches not opting to A.C.E. certify. In addition, leagues may background check any adult, but only non-A.C.E. Managers/Coaches are required to attend the training.

Training Policy

The fee for the CCASA training program is included in the background check fee.

Online A.C.E. fees are: \$25 for Level I and \$20 for Level II, III or IV.

Recreational League – All Managers/Coaches must meet one of the following criteria:

1) Have a current A.C.E. Certification [Obtained at www.registerASA.com]

or

2) Attend the CCASA Training Program

The CCASA Training program is open to all recreational league Managers/Coaches. It will be a two hour session broken into two parts as follows:

Part 1 (1st time coaches only) – View the A.C.E. training video followed by a quiz.

Part 2 (all coaches) – An open forum which may include new playing rules for the current year, scorekeeping 101 and a Q&A with guest speakers assigned to the training. The Q&A should cover problem coaching areas NOT player instruction...i.e. How to handle a problem parent, getting along with umpires, how to control rowdy fans, playing time issues and so on. Again, not proper hitting techniques.

Recreational League All-Star Teams – All Managers/Coaches must hold a current A.C.E. certification. The certification must be displayed during all tournament games.

Failure to provide A.C.E. certification upon request will result in immediate removal of that Manager/coach from the tournament.

"A" Travel Teams – All Managers/Coaches must hold a current A.C.E. certification. The certification must be displayed during all tournament games.

Failure to provide A.C.E. certification upon request will result in immediate removal of that Manager/coach from the tournament.
